



Born in Sant Pere de Riudebitlles in 1984, Cesk Freixas is a poet, singer and songwriter. His father was a carpenter, a family tradition that ran for six generations, and it's the bond he's established with the artisanal work of music. As a result, he often likes to introduce himself as a *song carpenter*. A geographer by training, he has published eight records, three poetry books and two children's stories. In 2021 he's published *Memòria*, the most representative album of his musical career. He evokes all the poetic maturity and the essence of a warmer and closer sound, positioning him as one of the leading artists in his style in our country. He now celebrates 17 years on stage, and he does so with the careful and detailed arrangements of Víctor Nin, the grand guitarist that has been with him since his beginnings.

Canya d'or is a gralla formation set up in the autumn of 1997 in Reus. The gralla is a musical instrument like a shawm, used mainly in popular Catalan music. From the traditional formation of three grallas and a drum, the street is its natural stage, moving amid folk parades, concerts and popular balls. Their original and varied repertoire and broad experience have established them as a reference group in gralla music. In addition, their interest and desire to renew the gralla folk scene has boosted the growth of this group by enriching itself with other musicians and in different formats. All this has made it possible to offer a broad range of music in their shows.

This year they are preparing what will be their second record to celebrate their 25th anniversary.




This concert gives a personal view of the tunes that are part of the popular culture of Sitges, such as the folk dances of the Festa Major and themes by composers such as Enric

Under the Sitges starry night, we'll see how they coexist with the historic centre and contemporary art.



In it, we'll see some of the buildings that still preserve all the dignity that only time and history can give. Besides, it houses one of the most important international contemporary art collections in Catalonia, the Stämpfli Foundation, created by the Swiss artist Peter Stampfli and his wife, Anna Maria.

NIT D'ESTELS I MAR AL MARICEL

Sitges is a village facing the sea, just like its museums. Escorted by the museum director, you will tour various depictions of the sea, the ships and the marine life that we find at the permanent exhibition of the Maricel Museum, and we'll dig out a collection of stories and legends. Further, we'll see and touch some objects that are usually out of reach, part of the marine collection from Emerencià Roig. The use of these items was to position the ships from the stars, the only way to know one's position until the invention of the GPS, used by the local people who came back from Cuba in the 19th century.

To round the visit, the <u>Garraf Astronomy</u> <u>Observatory</u> will show us the sky with a telescope. First, we will look for all the stars we can see with the naked eye. Then, with the telescope, we will identify the subtle rings of Saturn, and we will lose ourselves among the depths of our starry environment. Plus, we may be able to see the Perseids asteroid shower.

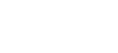
A journey through the history of wine around the Sitges Malmsey and Art.

Will we be able to make a good drum roll?


FOLK MUSIC WORKSHOP (FLAVIOL DE GRALLA)

SITGES MUSEUMS CAU FERRAT MUSEUM AND MARICEL MUSEUM



The Cau Ferrat Museum was opened in 1893 by the artist, writer and collector Santiago Rusiñol as a house-atelier that still keeps the modernist spirit. The Maricel Museum shows a complete artistic itinerary from the 10th century to the realism of the 20th century through Dr Jesús Pérez-Rosales collections and the town of Sitges.







